Injured Motorcyclist Receives \$1,100,000 After Collision

Our motorcyclist client incurred more than \$660,000 in medical bills after an accident left him with substantial injuries.

During a regular ride, he was hit by a negligent driver that made a reckless left turn in front of him. Following the accident, the insurance company argued that our client had a good recovery and proposed a low initial offer.

Hupy and Abraham, S.C. demonstrated that the severity of our client's injuries were exactly what he claimed. This convinced the insurance company to pay the \$1.1 million policy limits.

\$275,000 Awarded to Bicyclist Hit by Driver

While riding her bicycle during the winter, our client was hit by an elderly driver and suffered severe injuries that required surgery. The insurance company tried to avoid compensating our client, claiming she was intoxicated and riding incorrectly. Hupy and Abraham, S.C. proved that she was wearing bright, protective clothing and was following safety procedures. A lawsuit was filed, and the insurance company reversed its initial claims settling for \$275,000.

Back to School Safety Review

August is known as Back-to-School Safety Month – a time to remind parents, children and drivers to be vigilant regarding the increased activity of school-aged children in the community. Drivers should remember to:

- Slow down and be alert in residential neighborhoods and school zones.
- Take extra time to look for children at intersections, curbs and between cars.
- Enter and exit driveways and alleys slowly and double-check for children.
- Watch for children on and near the road before and after school hours.
- Reduce any distractions inside your car by turning down music and putting away your phone to avoid talking or texting while driving.

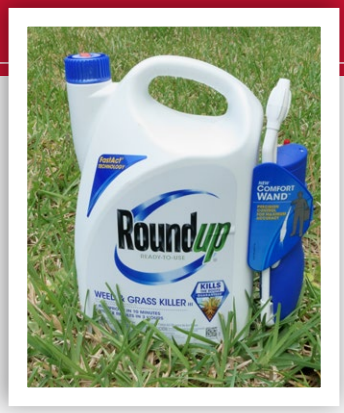

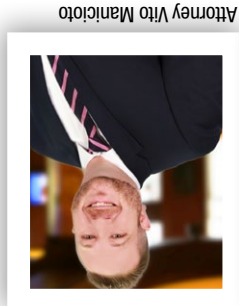

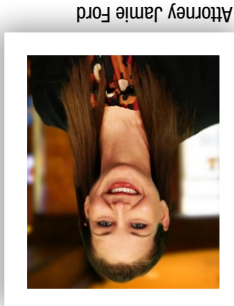
